

Joint Commission Public Notice

The Joint Commission conducts unannounced accreditation surveys at Palisades Medical Center. The purpose of these surveys will be to evaluate the organization's compliance with nationally established Joint Commission standards. The survey results will be used to determine whether, and the conditions under which, accreditation should be awarded the organization.

Joint Commission standards deal with organizational quality of care issues and the safety of the environment in which care is provided.
